### **Confession of Sin & Assurance of Pardon**

C: We have become impatient with those you have graciously placed in our lives and often lacked the energy to even repent.

*L: We are embarrassed by our secret thoughts and feel the weight of our sins with deep remorse.*

C: We need mercy. We need grace. We need forgiveness. We are full of need so propel our faith in this hour.

*L: LORD of Heaven and Earth, God and Father of our Savior, Jesus Christ; pour out your Spirit in abounding measure.*

C: Overwhelm us with the power of the cross. (time for silent confession)

*L: Dear children of God, beloved by Father, Son and Holy Spirit. You have been made clean and you are heirs with your elder brother and shepherd, Jesus Christ. Hallelujah! What a Savior!*

#### **Song of Preparation: 596 | You Came to Us Dear Jesus in Our Dying**

## **How to scan a QR code with your Apple device:**

1. Open the Camera app from the Home screen, Control Center, or Lock screen.
2. Select the rear facing camera. Hold your device so that the QR code appears in the viewfinder in the Camera app. Your device recognizes the QR code and shows a notification.
3. Tap the notification to open the link associated with the QR code.

## **How to check if your Android phone camera automatically scans QR Codes:**

1. Open your Camera app and point it steadily for 2-3 seconds towards the QR Code you want to scan.
2. Whenever scanning is enabled, a notification will appear.
3. If nothing happens, you may have to go to your Settings app and enable QR Code scanning.
