Meditation: Hebrews 12:3-6

Consider him who endured from sinners such hostility against himself, so that you may not grow weary or fainthearted. In your struggle against sin you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons? "My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when reproved by him. For the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives." It is for discipline that you have to endure. God is treating you as sons.

Corporate Confession of Sin & Assurance of Pardon

L: Dear God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, we confess aloud together that we have boasted out of our own ignorance rather than in the profound glory of the cross.

ALL: Though he was willing to suffer for us, we have spent a great deal of our energy avoiding inconvenience. If we are honest, we must say that we have not taken up our cross.

L: Instead, we find ourselves discontented with our provisions in life, eager to complain and criticize, and selfish with sharing what we have been given with others.

ALL: Though he was utterly obedient to the Father's will, we have spent a significant portion of our time being indifferent to his sacrifice rather than humbled.

L: We need correction. We need peace. We need mercy. We need love.

ALL: We need the marks of Jesus to rule our hearts, souls, minds and strength. We therefore ask for the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ to be with our spirits. Come Holy Spirit and minister to our broken hearts. [time for silent confession]

L: "Yet even now," declares the Lord, "return to me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning; and rend your hearts and not your garments." Return to the Lord your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love; and he relents over disaster.

How to scan a QR code with your Apple device:

1. Open the Camera app from the Home screen, Control Center, or Lock screen.
2. Select the rear facing camera. Hold your device so that the QR code appears in the viewfinder in the Camera app. Your device recognizes the QR code and shows a notification.
3. Tap the notification to open the link associated with the QR code.

How to check if your Android phone camera automatically scans QR Codes:

1. Open your Camera app and point it steadily for 2-3 seconds towards the QR Code you want to scan.
2. Whenever scanning is enabled, a notification will appear.
3. If nothing happens, you may have to go to your Settings app and enable QR Code scanning.
