#### **Meditation: Numbers 24:1-7**

When Balaam saw that it pleased the Lord to bless Israel, he did not go, as at other times, to look for omens, but set his face toward the wilderness. And Balaam lifted up his eyes and saw Israel camping tribe by tribe. And the Spirit of God came upon him, and he took up his discourse and said, "The oracle of Balaam the son of Beor, the oracle of the man whose eye is opened, the oracle of him who hears the words of God, who sees the vision of the Almighty, falling down with his eyes uncovered: How lovely are your tents, O Jacob, your encampments, O Israel! Like palm groves that stretch afar, like gardens beside a river, like aloes that the Lord has planted, like cedar trees beside the waters. Water shall flow from his buckets, and his seed shall be in many waters; his king shall be higher than Agag, and his kingdom shall be exalted."

#### Opening Hymn: To God Be the Glory | 55

#### **Questions for Reflection**

- 1. Reread chapter 2:1-11 and then read chapter 4:1-9. What is the connection between the mindset of humility and the list of virtues Paul gives in Phil. 4:8?
- 2. Scholars indicate that Paul's encouragement in Phil. 4:8 was also given by secular philosophers. Does this mean that both non-Christians and Christians can think in this way? If yes, how? If not, why?
- 3. Read Phil. 4:4-7. How does it relate to Phil. 4:8-9?
- 4. Paul says in 4:9 that he models this mindset. Do you model this mindset?
- 5. Phil. 4:8 is a mirror for our thought life. Take a moment to examine your thought life. What areas of your thought life match up or don't match up to this list?
