#### Confession of Sin & Assurance of Pardon

Though he was willing to suffer for us, we have spent a great deal of our energy avoiding inconvenience. If we are honest, we must say that we have not taken up our cross. Instead, we find ourselves discontented with our provisions in life, eager to complain and criticize, and selfish with sharing what we have been given with others. Though he was utterly obedient to the Father's will, we have spent a significant portion of our time being indifferent to his sacrifice rather than humbled. We need correction. We need peace. We need mercy. We need love. We need the marks of Jesus to rule our hearts, souls, minds and strength. We therefore ask for the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ to be with our spirits. Come Holy Spirit and minister to our broken hearts.

A time of silent confession.

L: Hear the words of your Lord and Savior: All those the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never drive away. For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me. And this is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all those he has given me, but raise them up at the last day. For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day.

## **Questions for Reflection**

- 1. How are God's people held captive by this world (Col. 2:8)?
- 2. Paul uses (primarily) three illustrations to demonstrate how Christ sets us free from the bondage of the flesh: circumcision (vs. 11 and 13a), baptism (vs. 12), and debt (vs. 14). What is significant about these three illustrations and how do they set us free from the bondage of this world?
- 3. What does Paul's illustration of debt cancellation teach us about the need to forgive others? Remember Jesus' word in Matt. 6:12 and Luke 11:4.
- 4. What does Paul say have an appearance of wisdom, but have no value in stopping the indulgence of the flesh (Col. 2:20-23)?
- 5. What does have value in stopping the indulgence of the flesh (cf. Col. 3:1-17)?
