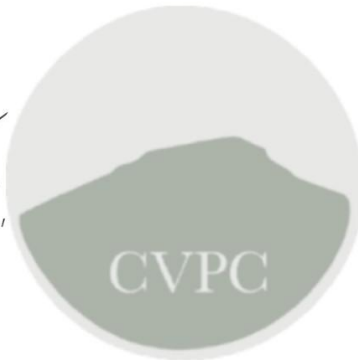

Questions for Reflection

1. There is a list of sins in chapter 3 (vs.5-9) and a list of virtues (vs.12-17). Compare and contrast the list of sins and virtues with other lists given by Paul in Gal. 5:19-24. What are the similarities and what are the differences?
2. Col. 3:1-11 makes clear that we have the power to commit sin, but do we (in our own strength) have the power to overcome sinful desires? How does being raised with Christ (Union with Christ) give a Christian the power to have victory over the desires of the flesh (Col. 3:1-4)?
3. In Col. 3:5-9, Paul spends a great deal of time highlighting sexual sin, why do you think that is the case? How does rampant sexual sin cause division and harm in our society?
4. In what ways does Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem (Matt. 21:1-11) make clear that one day we will be delivered from the power, the presence, and the penalty of sin?
