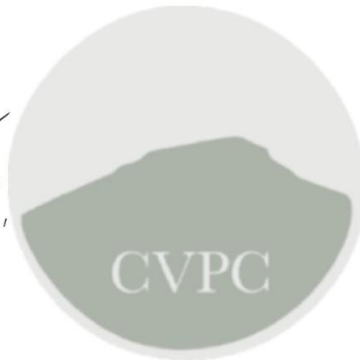

Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, obeyed the voice of the Lord their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the Lord their God had sent him. And the people feared the Lord. Then Haggai, the messenger of the Lord, spoke to the people with the Lord's message, "I am with you, declares the Lord." And the Lord stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people. And they came and worked on the house of the Lord of hosts, their God, on the twenty-fourth day of the month, in the sixth month, in the second year of Darius the king.

Call to Worship: Psalm 46

L: This is the Word of the LORD!

Sermon: "Gospel Transformation"

Hymn of Response: Abide with Me | 402

Questions for Reflection: 2 Corinthians 5:11-21

1. To better understand Paul's message in 2 Cor. 5:11-21, look for all the times Paul uses the word, 'therefore' in this passage. Look at what comes before and after the 'therefore'. What conclusions can you draw from Paul's 'therefore' statement? What does it reveal about his heart for the church at Corinth?

2. Personal transformation is at the heart of the gospel. How does Paul address the theme of personal (gospel) transformation in this section (focus on vs. 14-21)?

Read passages like Rom. 12:1-2 and 2 Cor. 4:16 and Eph. 4:17-32.

3. Why is being 'in Christ' such an important element to gospel transformation (vs. 17)? Describe some of the benefits of being 'in Christ' (Use WCF chapter 26 for the answer).

4. Paul says that if anyone is in Christ, the Old has passed away, and the new has come. What is the 'old' that is passing away? What is the 'new' that has come? (Read 2 Cor. 3 for more context).

5. Because we have been reconciled to God (the grounds for transformation), Paul says that we are ambassadors of Christ. What have we been made ambassadors of?

6. Pause and consider the ways the Holy Spirit is transforming you into being more like Christ? How do you see the Holy Spirit transforming those around you?

7. When was the last time you told someone about the gospel's transforming work in your life?
