Welcome and Greeting

Meditation: Psalm 18:1-19 | Reader: Karen Leavengood

I love you, O Lord, my strength. The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer, my God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. I call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised, and I am saved from my enemies. The cords of death encompassed me; the torrents of destruction assailed me; the cords of Sheol entangled me; the snares of death confronted me. In my distress I called upon the Lord; to my God I cried for help. From his temple he heard my voice, and my cry to him reached his ears. Then the earth reeled and rocked; the foundations also of the mountains trembled and quaked, because he was angry. Smoke went up from his nostrils, and devouring fire from his mouth; glowing coals flamed forth from him. He bowed the heavens and came down; thick darkness was under his feet. He rode on a cherub and flew; he came swiftly on the wings of the wind. He made darkness his covering, his canopy around him, thick clouds dark with water. Out of the brightness before him hailstones and coals of fire broke through his clouds. The Lord also

thundered in the heavens, and the Most High uttered his voice, hailstones and coals of fire. And he sent out his arrows and scattered them; he flashed forth lightnings and routed them. Then the channels of the sea were seen, and the foundations of the world were laid bare at your rebuke, O Lord, at the blast of the breath of your nostrils. He sent from on high, he took me; he drew me out of many waters. He rescued me from my strong enemy and from those who hated me, for they were too mighty for me. They confronted me in the day of my calamity, but the Lord was my support. He brought me out into a broad place; he rescued me, because he delighted in me.

L: The Lord lives, and blessed be my rock, and exalted be the God of my salvation—the God who gave me vengeance and subdued peoples under me,

ALL: Who rescued me from my enemies; yes, you exalted me above those who rose against me; you delivered me from the man of violence.

ALL: Great salvation he brings to his king, and shows steadfast love to his anointed, to David and his offspring forever.

L: This is the Word of the Lord!

ALL: Thanks be to God.

Word: Ecclesiastes 2:18-26; Genesis 3:24;

Song of the Month: Whate'er My God Ordains is Right | 108

- 1. Whate'er my God ordains is right: his holy will abideth; I will be still whate'er he doth, and follow where he guideth. He is my God: though dark my road, he holds me that I shall not fall: wherefore to him I leave it all.
- 2. Whate'er my God ordains is right: he never will deceive me; he leads me by the proper path; I know he will not leave me. I take, content, what he hath sent; his hand can turn my griefs away, and patiently I wait his day.

Questions for Reflection

1. In Ecclesiastes 2:18–20, Solomon explains the vanity of toiling. Why does the Preacher feel despair?

2. Why does Solomon hate all his toil (2:18)? What might be a way around this hatred, so that we could actually enjoy our toil and life?

3. At the end of Chapter 2, Solomon expresses that "there is nothing better for a person than that he should eat and drink and find enjoyment in his toil" (2:24). How is this enjoyment to be viewed? How does the Preacher arrive at this conclusion?
