#### **Welcome and Greeting**

#### **Meditation: Jeremiah 1:4-10 | Reader: Daniel Dukes**

Now the word of the Lord came to Jeremiah, saying, "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations." Then I said, "Ah, Lord God! Behold, I do not know how to speak, for I am only a youth." But the Lord said to me, "Do not say, 'I am only a youth'; for to all to whom I send you, you shall go, and whatever I command you, you shall speak. Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you to deliver you, declares the Lord." Then the Lord put out his hand and touched my mouth. And the Lord said to me, "Behold, I have put my words in your mouth. See, I have set you this day over nations and over kingdoms, to pluck up and to break down, to destroy and to overthrow, to build and to plant."

## **Call to Worship: Psalm 45:6-16**

L: Your throne, O God, is forever and ever. The scepter of your kingdom is a scepter of uprightness; you have loved righteousness and hated wickedness. Therefore God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness beyond your companions;

**ALL: Your robes are all fragrant with myrrh and aloes and cassia. From ivory palaces stringed instruments make you glad; daughters of kings are among your ladies of honor; at your right hand stands the queen in gold of Ophir.**

L: Hear, O daughter, and consider, and incline your ear: forget your people and your father's house, and the king will desire your beauty.

**ALL: Since he is your lord, bow to him. The people of Tyre will seek your favor with gifts, the richest of the people. All glorious is the princess in her chamber, with robes interwoven with gold. In many-colored robes, she is led to the king, with her virgin companions following behind her.**

L: With joy and gladness, they are led along as they enter the palace of the king. In place of your fathers shall be your sons; you will make them princes in all the earth.

**ALL: I will cause your name to be remembered in all generations; therefore, nations will praise you forever and ever.**

L: This is the Word of the Lord!

**ALL: Thanks be to God!**
