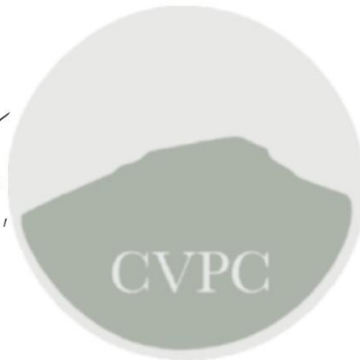

Now there was a disciple at Damascus named Ananias. The Lord said to him in a vision, "Ananias." And he said, "Here I am, Lord." And the Lord said to him, "Rise and go to the street called Straight, and at the house of Judas look for a man of Tarsus named Saul, for behold, he is praying, and he has seen in a vision a man named Ananias come in and lay his hands on him so that he might regain his sight." But Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much evil he has done to your saints at Jerusalem. And here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all who call on your name." But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen instrument of mine to carry my name before the Gentiles and kings and the children of Israel. For I will show him how much he must suffer for the sake of my name." So Ananias departed and entered the house. And laying his hands on him he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus who appeared to you on the road by which you came has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit." And immediately something like scales fell from his eyes, and he regained his sight. Then he rose and was baptized; and taking food, he was strengthened.

Call to Worship: Psalm 21

L: O Lord, in your strength the king rejoices, and in your salvation how greatly he exults! You have given him his heart's desire and have not withheld the request of his lips.

ALL: For you meet him with rich blessings; you set a crown of fine gold upon his head. He asked life of you; you gave it to him, length of days forever and ever.

L: His glory is great through your salvation; splendor and majesty you bestow on him. For you make him most blessed forever; you make him glad with the joy of your presence.

ALL: For the king trusts in the Lord, and through the steadfast love of the Most High he shall not be moved. Your hand will find out all your enemies; your right hand will find out those who hate you.

L: You will make them as a blazing oven when you appear. The Lord will swallow them up in his wrath, and fire will consume them. You will destroy their descendants from the earth, and their offspring from among the children of man.

ALL: Though they plan evil against you, though they devise mischief, they will not succeed. For you will put them to flight; you will aim at their faces with your bows.

L: Be exalted, O Lord, in your strength!

ALL: We will sing and praise your power.

L: This is the Word of the LORD!

ALL: Thanks be to God.

Hymn of Adoration: To God be the Glory| 55

1. To God be the glory, great things he has done! So loved he the world that he gave us his Son, who yielded his life an atonement for sin, and opened the life-gate that we may go in.

Confession of Sin & Assurance of Pardon

ALL: O LORD, we now pray in your presence this day for those servants you have gathered at Chattanooga Valley Presbyterian Church. We confess the sins that we have deliberately and unintentionally committed. We have sinned against you. Also, our family members have sinned against you despite your clear commands. We stand justly condemned if it were not for your grace and forgiveness.

We have acted very corruptly against you and have not kept the commandments you gave to your servant Moses nor have our motives been in keeping with Jesus' directives in the Sermon on the Mount. We are your children by your grace and yet we sometimes live as if we were your enemies. We act as if we are cursed slaves rather than blessed sons and daughters as we are truly. O Lord, hear the prayers of your servants. Hear us, we who sincerely want to deeply love you and reverently fear your name. Give us success in this hour so that we may sincerely honor you as our Father from the inside out. Grant us more mercy and strength for the sake of Jesus Christ—the mediator of the New Covenant, our Savior, your only begotten Son, and our elder brother.

(A time for silent confession.)

L: And these things we write, so that our joy may be made complete. And this is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is light, and in Him there is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth; but if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.
