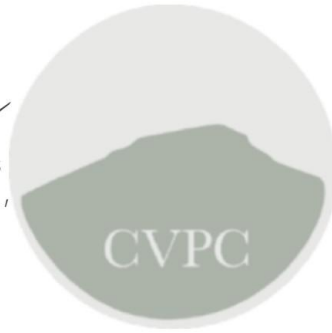

Invocation

You have said in your Word that we are to ask for anything we lack according to what you have promised. Please meet us in this hour that we may behold your glory once again. Welcome and Greeting

Meditation: Revelation 2:1-7 | Reader: Steve Rapier

To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: “The words of him who holds the seven stars in his right hand, who walks among the seven golden lampstands. ‘I know your works, your toil and your patient endurance, and how you cannot bear with those who are evil, but have tested those who call themselves apostles and

are not, and found them to be false. I know you are enduring patiently and bearing up for my name's sake, and you have not grown weary. But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first. Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first. If not, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent. Yet this you have: you hate the works of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate. He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To the one who conquers I will grant to eat of the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God.”

Call to Worship: Isaiah 45:20-45

L: Assemble yourselves and come; draw near together, you survivors of the nations! They have no knowledge who carry about their wooden idols, and keep on praying to a god that cannot save.

ALL: Declare and present your case; let them take counsel together! Who told this long ago? Who declared it of old?

L: Was it not I, the Lord? And there is no other god besides me, a righteous God and a Savior; there is none besides me.

ALL: Turn to me and be saved, all the ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other.

L: By myself I have sworn; from my mouth has gone out in righteousness a word that shall not return: ‘To me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear allegiance.

ALL: Only in the Lord, it shall be said of me, are righteousness and strength; to him shall come and be ashamed all who were incensed against him. In the Lord all the offspring of Israel shall be justified and shall glory.

L: This is the Word of the Lord!

ALL: Thanks be to God.

Questions for Reflection: Exodus 20:1-17 and Deuteronomy 5:6-21

1. Why is it significant that God wrote the 10 commandments with His own finger? (Ex. 31:18)
2. Why did God remind the children of Israel that he brought them out of Egypt out of the house of bondage (Ex. 20:2)? What does the pattern of redemption and then call to obedience tell us about the gospel?
3. The 10 commandments are the centerpiece of the covenant God made with Israel on Mount Sinai. Why do you think God gave them these commandments as part of their covenant responsibilities?

4. If the 10 commandments are so crucial for ethical formation, why did God wait until Mount Sinai to give them to His people?

5. How do we see Jesus in the 10 commandments?
