#### **Meditation: Psalm 18:1-6 | Reader: Pippa Topping**

**Question for Reflection: Ephesians 5:1-17**

1. The text makes clear that God has already forgiven these gentile believers of their sins (Eph. 1:1, 5, 11; 2:1-10; 4:17-32). Why then does Paul rehash past sins in Eph. 5:3-12? What point do you think he is trying to get across?

2. Paul tells the church to walk (meaning how we should live) in love (Eph. 5:1), walk in light (Eph. 5:8), and walk in wisdom (Eph. 5:15). How do these exhortations aid us to remain pure?

3. What hope does this passage give for those who have fallen in this area? What practical wisdom does Paul give to protect our hearts and guard our actions against purity?
